



Game Guarantee Cup

We are aware that team's appetite for friendlies has diminished over the last couple of years and because of this, we have created a concept to remove friendlies and introduce a competitive alternative. We are calling it the Game Guarantee Cup!

When our office team know you don't have an opposition we will arrange a Cup Game match instead.

How it Works:

- GGC seasons run in 3 month periods; January to March, April to June, July to September and October to December
- GGC leagues will cover games played in our local leagues at Regular Venues across geographical areas such as North West England, Kent, etc.
- Teams must play a minimum of 2 GGC fixtures within the time period to be included
- An updated league table will be shared with teams and event staff weekly
- Standard doesn't matter as points only count after you've played 2 GGC games

Costs:

- For the team whose normal weekly game isn't being played, the match will be £10 cheaper than the normal league match fee
- For a team who play an extra game as well as their normal fixture, the fee is just £10
- If a team choose not to play, and the GGC game is scheduled for the same time as their league match a charge is incurred. This would be the cost of the GGC game (£10 lower than usual fee).

Prize for winners:

The winning team in each GGC league will be decided by who has the greatest average points earned and will win:

- 25% discount on league match fees for the following season
- Boot bag for each player (5 for 5-a-side etc, while stocks last)
- Winners Trophy
- Winners Medals

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: What if my team don't want to play their GGC match?

A: The discounted GGC fee would still be charged but the team would be welcome to use the pitch. This would only apply if the game offered was at the same time as your original league fixture

Q: What if Powerleague can't arrange the team a game?

A: If we cannot offer a fixture at the same time as your league fixture (and you can't make the alternative time) no fee would be charged to the team and you would be awarded a 5-0 walkover win

Q: What if the fixture is a first kick off?

A: We will still try to offer a fixture to the team but appreciate this may be more difficult – the points above will be applied when doing so

Q: What if the absent team don't make us aware of their absence so we can't arrange the game?

A: Our Event Manager would look to arrange a GGC match on the night. The discounted rate would still apply for the team with no opposition.

Q: Can a team request a PPG fixture on another night or another league?

A: Yes! Teams are welcome to play on other nights & would be charged as above

Q: How do I know what leagues are included other than my own?

A: This will be detailed in communication from your league manager on a weekly basis, as well as the updated league table or you can request this at any time!

Q: Why does the Game Guarantee Cup run seasonally?

A: As this is run across leagues in the region seasons will start and finish at different times meaning it is not possible to run at the same times as the regular seasons.
